

August 11, 1959:

Olgiate Olona Council resolution No. 119a for the erection of the monument in memory of the plane crash

The Council, listened to the report made by the Mayor on the tragic event and about the urgent measures adopted; considered that some esteemed professionals and a worthy graduating architect of Olgiate Olona (engineers Luigi Rabolini and Nicola Fraenza and Mr. Tiberio Merelli) spontaneously prepared a draft free of charge for arranging the area where the plane crashed; ascertained that the owners of the land - Mr. Codecà - asked for a total price of £ 150,000 for the sale; given that a fund of £ 600,000 was specifically allocated with earlier measure; by unanimous vote expressed according to the law, resolves to approve the proposed arrangement of the area where the aircraft crashed as prepared by engineers Luigi Rabolini and Nicola Fraenza and by graduating architect Mr. Tiberio Merelli; to purchase the required area by Mr. Codecà at the price stated; to authorize by law the town Council to perform any act for the purpose; to collect the amount of expenditure by the related fund of £ 600.000, with art. 90 bis, Tit. 1st, Ch. 4th, Cat. 8th ("Extraordinary expenses following the plane crash occurred in Olgiate Olona on June 26, 1959").
