

COMMEMORATIVE EVENTS REWARDED IN 2011 WITH THE MEDAL OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE ITALIAN REPUBLIC

Olgiate Olona and the memory of the plane crash in prayer: until June 26, 2021, suffrage Masses for the seventy immortal lives every two months in the Prevostal church

After the 60th anniversary, the memory of the plane crash continues with the prayer in Olgiate Olona: with the offers of Euros 300 and Dollars 50 collected during the ceremony of June 26, 2019, in the Ancient Collegiate Prevostal church of St. Stephen and Lawrence of Olgiate Olona, Masses in suffrage for the seventy immortal lives will be celebrated in the same church.

By proposing and pursuing this purpose, the promoting staff of the commemorative events of June 26, 1959, thanks everyone for their generosity, does not offend the immortal lives whose creed was not the Catholic one, involves the community of Olgiate Olona in prayer for the souls of those perished in the crash; and as well as of memory, the episcopal vicar Monsignor Luca Raimondi talked about prayer in his homily during the celebration of the 60th anniversary held on June 26, 2019: *Prayer: for a believer, prayer is everything but also it honours those who do not believe. In fact, prayer is expressed not only in words but it is even more precious when it is silence, it unites believers and non-believers. For me, a Christian, being here to pray, with this Eucharist of suffrage for these 70 souls, means to nourish a hope. The hope lies in the words of Jesus that we have just heard: "In the house of my Father there are many dwelling places. I go to prepare a place for you, because where I am, there you may be also". Today I pray with all the strength of my heart for these 70 souls because I have the certainty that they are now with the Lord. For me, a Christian, death has no right to put an end to anything.*

The promoting staff of the commemorative events of June 26, 1959, has already given the pastor of Olgiate Olona don Giulio Bernardoni the total amount collected, allocating one hundred Euros for the ceremony of June 26, 2019, and the remaining two hundred Euros and fifty Dollars for the prayer in suffrage for the seventy immortal lives: Masses every two months (from July 22, 2019, through June 26, 2021), remembering those born in the month when the Mass is celebrated, preferring prefestive and festive Masses (widely attended by churchgoers),

choosing the date – if possible - in which some of those remembered were born, offering twenty Euros for each mass.

These are the dates of the Masses of suffrage (which will also be periodically remembered on the website *OlgiateOlona26giugno1959.org*) and the names of the immortal lives which will be remembered:
